St. Tammany Humane Society is actively seeking individual and corporate sponsors for its Duck Derby fundraiser, an event that must be seen to be believed.

At high noon, Saturday, July 18, 5,000 "adopted" rubber ducks will be dropped into the Bogue Falaya River in a race to the finish within the Bogue Falaya Park itself in Covington. Top prize for the winning duck is \$1,000.

Admission to the park for this dog-friendly event is free, with various food vendors available and games galore beginning at 10 a.m. Egging on the ducks and entertaining the attendees will be the music of Christian Serpas and Ghost Town. Some of the adoptable animals from STHS will also be there in search of their forever homes.

Every "adopted" rubber duck helps a dog or cat in the care of STHS while helping to further their ongoing mission. The adoption fee is \$5 per duck, and can be adopted singly or in flocks online now at Sttammanyduckderby.com, or in person at the shelter, Zorro's Fun Zone for Pets, or The Scotts' Coffee and Tapas Bar.
