

Kiwanis Ducks For Bucks race raises \$29,000

Sponsored by Kiwanis Club of Fremont, Saturday's 21st annual Tri Cities Ducks For Bucks benefit race at Lake Elizabeth in Fremont's Central Park raised a preliminary total of \$29,000, more than double last year's number, organizers said.

The rubber duck race featured about 5,400 of the bright yellow toys more commonly seen floating in bath tubs. All money goes to Tri-City schools and charities. A year ago, more than \$14,000 was raised.

A duck "adopted" by Patricia A. Heer won her a \$2,000 cash grand prize. California Retired Teachers Association No. 91 was the selling organization.

Festivities included a free family carnival with games and prizes, a jump house and music by Dixie Dominus Jazz Band of Fremont Christian School.
